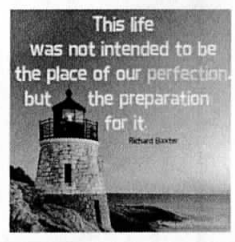
## **Shalom Fellowship**

There will be over 20 people sleeping in the church hall through February and the beginning of March. Thank you for coping with the extra load the shelter brings and trust it will go smoothly as it has previous years. The Shelter finishes on Monday 9th March.
