The Nottingham Night Shelter and The Nottingham Winter Shelter are now an integral part of the plan to reduce homelessness in the city of Nottingham. The shelter is now running for 12 months of the year, separated into 2 projects covering the summer and the winter period and currently supports 2 people each week out of rough sleeping into accommodation.

The winter shelter is appreciative of our support. The shelter has started well. Please keep this work in prayer and the clients using the service. There will be over 20 people sleeping in the church hall through February and the beginning of March. Thank you for coping with the extra load the shelter brings and trust it will go smoothly as it has previous years. The Shelter finishes on Monday 9th March.
